

## **Ralston House Quick Facts**

All kids deserve to be safe & heard. Kids who have suffered abuse find a safe space to tell their story at Ralston House.

- Ralston House is a Child Advocacy Center. Children that have experienced or witnessed physical or sexual abuse will come to Ralston House to be interviewed instead of a police station.
- Ralston House provides services in your community with 3 locations in Lakewood, Arvada, and Northglenn
- Ralston House works directly with law enforcement, district attorneys and child protective services to schedule interviews with children
- Services at Ralston House are **FREE** to families which include forensic interviews, victim advocacy, and medical wellness checks.
- **70%** of children interviewed have experienced **sexual abuse**, 20% physical abuse and 10% witness to domestic violence or crime
- Ralston House is a comfortable family-friendly place where children feel safe to share their experience
- Ralston House interviews over **1,000** children each year
- Ralston House interviews children that are victims of human trafficking or witness to crime
